

**CITY OF CLARKSVILLE
CITY COUNCIL DEPARTMENT MEETING
JULY 16, 2012**

The Clarksville City Council met in regular session July 16, 2012, in the Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor David Kelm in the chair and Council members Cathy Cummings, Jeff Kolb, Mike Miller, Diane Renning, and Val Swinton present.

The following Department Heads were in attendance: Kristen Clark, Library Director; Dan Cummings, Police Chief; Matt Kampman, Ground Maintenance; and Larry Betts, Financial Administration.

Motion Kolb, Miller, to approve the monthly Library reports submitted by Kristen Clark.

Motion Kolb, Swinton, to approve the resignation of Jason Benson as a member on the Clarksville Fire Department.

Motion Kolb, Cummings, to adopt Resolution 12-518: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, IOWA, 2012 FISCAL YEAR STREET FINANCIAL REPORT.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Clarksville, Iowa:

1. Approves the report as its official Fiscal Year Street Finance Report to the Iowa Department of Transportation for the City of Clarksville, Iowa, as required by the Code of Iowa, Chapter 312, Section 14 and 15. Expenditures and receipts for period of July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012.

2. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and report issued to the Iowa Department of Transportation.

Motion Kolb, Swinton, to adopt the first reading of Ordinance No. 257: TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TURNING REGULATIONS.

Section I. Chapter 64, Section **64.03 NO LEFT TURN FOR PARKING** is amended by adding a paragraph:


"Admitted violations of parking restrictions imposed by this Code of Ordinances may be charged upon a simple notice of a fine payable at the office of the City Clerk. The simple notice of a fine shall be in the amount of twenty dollars (\$20.00). In the case that such fine is not paid within the time indicated on the notice, than it shall be grounds for filing of a complaint in District Court with the appropriate surcharge and court costs being applied."

Section II. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage of the City Council and after publication.
