AUGUST 20, 2012**

Motion Miller, Swinton, to approve the monthly Library reports submitted by Kristen Clark.

Motion Swinton, Cummings, to adopt the first reading of Ordinance No. 258: TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARKING REGULATIONS.

Section I. Chapter 69, **PARKING REGULATIONS** is amended by adding a new section:

“69.14 **PARKING LIMITED TO ONE HOUR PARKING**. It is unlawful to park any vehicle for a continuous period of more than one (1) hour from 7:00 a.m. to 4 p.m. (during regular school hours) upon the following designated streets:

1. Mather Street, west side of the north one-half (1/2) of the block & all the east side of the block between Prospect Street and Wamsley Avenue.
2. Mather Street, both sides of block between Wamsley Avenue and Slimmer Avenue.”

Section II. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage of the City Council and after publication.
