

**CITY OF CLARKSVILLE
CITY COUNCIL BUSINESS MEETING
SEPTEMBER 2, 2014**

The Clarksville City Council met in regular session September 2, 2014, in the Council Chambers of City Hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor David Kelm in the chair and Council members Cathy Cummings, Jeff Kolb, Diane Renning, Travis Sterken, and Val Swinton present.

Motion Kolb, Swinton, to approve and adopt the items contained on the Consent Agenda: Motion to approve minutes (August 4, 2014 and August 18, 2014); and financial reports.

Motion Cummings, Swinton, to authorize the committee to move forward with fundraising and grants to purchase and install lighting for City/School ball diamond per estimate from Musco Sports Lighting Company. Final project to be awarded as funds are committed.

Mayor tabled a request for a building permit submitted by Dan Rambo, 414 E. Poisal, for the construction of a six (6) foot fence, due to the need of a variance – per City Code, Chapter 155, Section 155.07 FENCING - On street frontage lot lines, corner lots and for any front yards, the height shall not exceed four (4) feet.

Motion Kolb, Renning, to approve the Mayor's appointment of the Police Chief and Maintenance Superintendent as Code Compliance Officers for the City of Clarksville, due to the resignation of Doug Bird.

Motion Renning, Cummings, to set a Public Hearing on September 15, 2014, in the City Hall at 7:00 p.m., for informing the public of indebtedness to secure funds for a loan to support local effort in the amount of \$100,000.00 for Public Safety and Public Works equipment.
