

**CITY OF CLARKSVILLE
CITY COUNCIL BUSINESS MEETING
MARCH 7, 2016**

The Clarksville City Council met in regular session March 7, 2016, in the Council Chambers of City Hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Val Swinton in the chair and Council members Roger Doty, Jeff Kolb, Diane Renning, Kenneth Smith, and Travis Sterken present.

Mayor Swinton opened the public hearing on the proposed 2016-2017 City Budget Estimate. The Budget Estimate was considered and taxpayers for and against said estimate were heard. There being no written or oral, for or against the proposed City Budget Estimate, the Mayor declared the hearing closed.

Motion Kolb, Sterken, to adopt Resolution 16-596: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, IOWA, ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2017.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Iowa:

The annual budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 as set forth in the Budget Summary and in the detailed budget in support thereof showing the revenue estimates and appropriation expenditures and allocations to programs and activities for said fiscal year is adopted, and the clerk is directed to make the filings required by law and to set up his books in accordance with the summary and details as adopted.

Motion Kolb, Sterken, to adopt Resolution 16-595: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, IOWA FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF RESERVE PEACE OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Clarksville is considering appointing reserve officers; and

WHEREAS, the reserve officers would be subordinate to regular peace officer, would not serve as a peace officer unless under the direction of regular peace officers, and would wear a uniform prescribed by the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the reserve officers would act only in a supplementary reserve capacity to the regular police force and would not assume full-time duties of regular peace officers without first complying with all requirements for regular peace officers as set forth by the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, position not subject to IPERS.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council appoints Cody Brown and Robert Landrum.

This appointment shall be effective March 8, 2016.
