

**CITY OF CLARKSVILLE  
CITY COUNCIL DEPARTMENT MEETING  
APRIL 17, 2017**

The Clarksville City Council met in regular session April 17, 2017, in the Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Val Swinton in the chair and Council members Roger Doty, Jeff Kolb, Diane Renning, Kenneth Smith, and Travis Sterken present.

The following Department Heads were in attendance: Kristen Clark, Library Director; Barry Mackey, Police Chief; Matt Kampman, Maintenance Superintendent; Ryan McCully, Maintenance Assistant; Lori Peterson and Kayla Hinders, Financial Administration.

Motion Kolb, Renning, to approve applications for Jared Ragsdale and Brandon Kramer as members of the Clarksville Fire Department.

Motion Renning, Kolb, to adopt Resolution 17-640: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLARKSVILLE, IOWA, TO ACCEPT RESIGNATION FROM CITY EMPLOYEE.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Iowa;

“WHEREAS Cody Niehaus has resigned as Reserve Peace Officer. Resignation is effective March 17, 2017.”

Motion Sterken, Doty, to adopt Resolution 17-641: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, IOWA FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A RESERVE PEACE OFFICER.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Clarksville is considering appointing a reserve officer; and

WHEREAS, the reserve officer would be subordinate to regular peace officer, would not serve as a peace officer unless under the direction of regular peace officers, and would wear a uniform prescribed by the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the reserve officer would act only in a supplementary reserve capacity to the regular police force and would not assume full-time duties of a regular peace officer without first complying with all requirements for regular peace officers as set forth by the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, position not subject to IPERS.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council appoints **Nathan Wright**. This appointment shall be effective April 17, 2017.

Motion Kolb, Renning, to adopt Resolution 17-641: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, IOWA, TO APPROVE AMENDING GARBAGE RATES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Clarksville, Iowa:

1. In accordance with Section 106.08 of the City Code, that the following monthly fees be amended:

A. Refuse collection with curb-side recycling for residences be set at:

35 gallon cart \$19.50

64 gallon cart \$24.50

96 gallon cart \$31.00

Official bags \$1.25 each

B. Refuse Disposal fee to Commercial Establishments be set at:

Base rate for Disposal Fee Service: \$8.00

Commercial Establishment with:

(1) Dumpster/once weekly pick up - Base rate plus \$7.00 = \$15.00

(2) Dumpster/twice weekly pick up - Base rate plus \$14.00 = \$22.00

(3) Dumpsters/once weekly pick up - Base rate plus \$14.00 = \$22.00

(4) or more Dumpsters/twice weekly pick up - Base rate plus \$21.00 = \$29.00

C. All Commercial Establishment collection fees are set by services received from approved contracted refuse company.

2. All fees based on six (6) months annual occupancy.

3. Such fees shall be effective May 1, 2017.

4. This resolution shall remain in full force and effect until amended by the City Council.
