

**CITY OF CLARKSVILLE  
CITY COUNCIL BUSINESS MEETING  
October 5, 2020**

The Clarksville City Council met in regular session on October 5, 2020, in the City Council Chambers at 6:30 p.m. with Mayor Kenneth Smith in the chair and Council Members Roger Doty, Todd Fails, Brock Lodge, and Larry Voigts present.

Motion Voigts, Doty, to approve and adopt the items contained in the Consent Agenda: Motion to approve minutes (September 8, 2020, and September 21, 2020).

Motion Fails, Doty, to adopt Resolution 20-734: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARKSVILLE, IOWA, TO APPROVE AMENDING BURIAL HOURS AT THE LYN-WOOD CEMETERY.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Clarksville, Iowa:

A. The price of lots within the Lyn-Wood Cemetery:

1. The price of lots within the Lyn-Wood Cemetery shall be \$300.00 for each grave space within the lot.
2. The price of lots within the Babyland section of the Lyn-Wood Cemetery shall be \$200.00 for each grave space.
3. Price includes perpetual care set at ten percent (10%) of the cost per gravesite.

B. The fee set for opening and closing:

1. The fee for opening and closing shall be \$450.00 on week days and \$750.00 on Saturdays and after hours. Sundays, City observed holidays, and holiday weekends excluded. There will be an additional \$150.00 fee if the ground needs to be thawed.
2. The fee for opening and closing for infants or cremations shall be \$250.00 on week days and \$550.00 on Saturdays and after hours. Sundays, City observed holidays, and holiday weekends excluded. There will be an additional \$150.00 fee if the ground needs to be thawed.

C. Cemetery maintenance staff is available Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

This resolution shall be effective October 5, 2020.
